Red Wednesday, 19h November.

The theme for this international day for the persecuted is 'A Global Cry for Religious Freedom.' Building's across the world from Toronto and Montreal to Australia, and Europe, including for the first time the European Parliament building in Brussels, will be lit in red to symbolise the blood shed by people of all faiths for their beliefs. 10,000 people are expected to attend events with 500,000 accessing events online. Please pray for all at home that day. Next year the European Parliament will be hosting a conference on religious persecution.
