Peace Sunday is on 18th January 2026. Pope Leo Published his World Day of Peace message shortly before Christmas. Affirming again that nonviolence is the key to peace, the message addresses the escalation of war, rearmament and fear in international relations. Pope Leo reiterates the church's opposition to deterrent's based on military force and calls for disarmament, dialogue and the conversion of hearts as necessary conditions for a lasting peace.
